

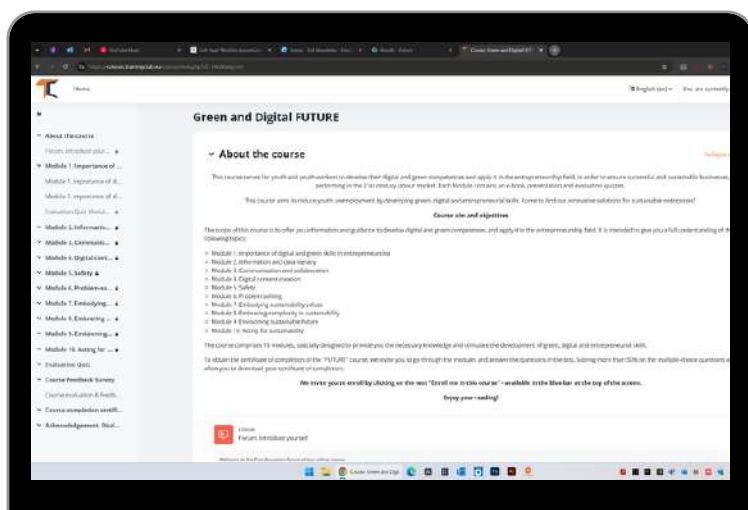
Empowering Youth with Green and Digital Entrepreneurship

The inspired Erasmus+ KA220 project FUTURE ("Entrepreneurship's FUTURE is green and digital", code: 2022-2-PT02-KA220-YOU-000098632) is already halfway through, and the planned activities are running on schedule, resulting in its effective completion and achievement of its goals. The project aims to provide educational resources to target the development of digital and green skills applied to entrepreneurship, in order to prepare future generations of entrepreneurs to provide innovative solutions to the existing demands in the society, and contribute to reducing youth unemployment.

The project's consortium, consisting of EducPro (Portugal – coordinator), ASEID Asociación para el Empleo, la Inclusión y el Desarrollo (Spain), Asociatia TEAM 4 Excellence (Romania), E-School Educational Group (Greece), and Efektas Group (Lithuania), continues to collaborate perfectly with professionalism, consistency, and dedication to the project's objectives, holding monthly online meetings and using the online collaboration platform to exchange views and contribute equally to the project's successful completion.



The training materials and activities are now available in English and all partner languages, and have been uploaded to the project's moodle platform and website, allowing for the upcoming delivery of courses for young aspiring entrepreneurs in today's demanding modern reality, as well as those working with youth in the fields of green and digital entrepreneurship.

In this context, and in accordance with the project's schedule, the training activity (LTTA) for young trainers in Braga, Portugal, from September 3 to 7, 2024, was carried out successfully from September 3 to 7, 2024. 'EducPro', being the coordinator of the project, was the host organization, while the other partners' organisations participated with four persons each. The training involved the participants presenting and implementing activities prepared in the context of the project's Work Package 3 (3 activities per partner) on green and digital entrepreneurship using the DigComp, GreenComp, and EntrComp frameworks. The LTTA program also included educational games and cultural activities, which made the experience more meaningful and gratifying for all participants.
